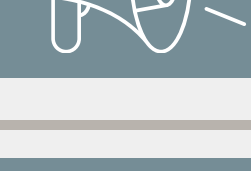

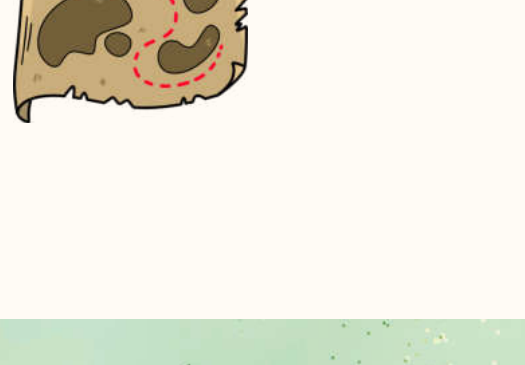

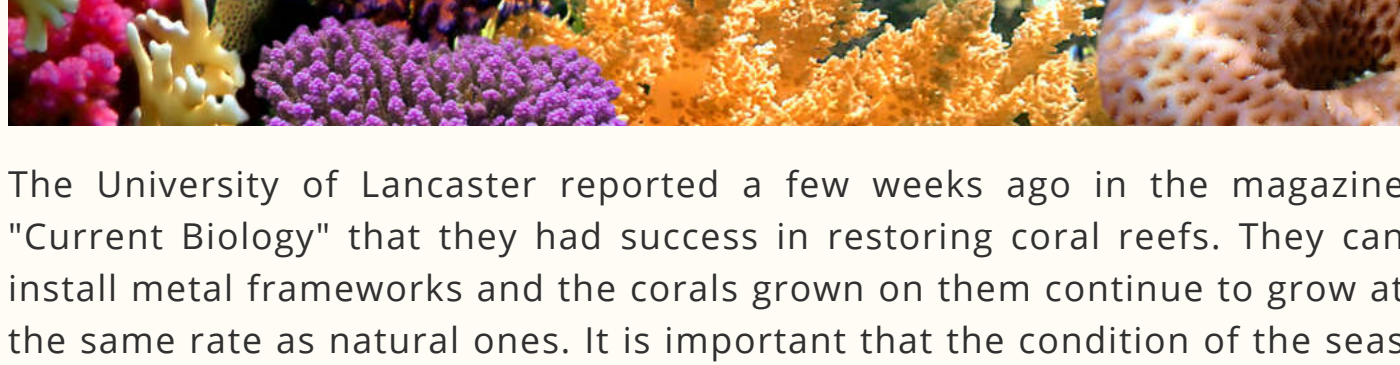
HÖR MAL WER DIE WELT VERÄNDERT
